Attached is a list of Fort Bragg commercial fishermen who have a great concern for the future of the Open Access Black Cod Fishery. When this fishery started, it was designed as a by-catch fishery. It has developed into a very important fishery that many depend on to help fill gaps left by closures and restrictions in other fisheries. A good example would be the 2015 crab fishery closure.

The issues of concern are as follows:

- 1. Quotas: The Open Access quota is small.
- 2. One Owner/Multiple Boats in Open Access Fishery: A limitation of the number of boats per person is needed. This would lead to a more equitable fishery for all. It would also help stretch the quota over a larger part of the year.
- 3. Gear Issues: A large number of black cod traps are being left in the water year round. This causes gear conflicts and unnecessary loss of fish.
