## CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE REPORT ON NON-TRAWL ROCKFISH CONSERVATION AREA MANAGEMENT – FINAL PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE




Figure 1. Proposed modification to address the crossover between the 60 and 75 fathom Rockfish Conservation Area boundary lines, south of Point Sur, CA.

During development of this agenda item, and in consultation with National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) West Coast Region staff, a crossover between the 60 and 75 fathom Rockfish Conservation Area boundary lines was identified in the area south of Point Sur, CA. Therefore, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) proposes the following technical correction to modify one 75 fathom boundary line waypoint to address the crossover (*Figure 1* and *Table 1*). CDFW looks forward to continued collaboration with NMFS to address any other crossovers or major technical issues on the 75 fathom boundary line.
